Each firm will have 30 minutes to present their concepts and answer questions from the audience. Participants will be able to rank the firms and provide comments on the selection.

Final Selection of the Planning Firm is scheduled for the Board of Trustee Meeting on December 10<sup>th</sup>.

**Background**

Pasadena City College has served the San Gabriel Valley community and greater Los Angeles Basin for the last 90 years and as the 100th Anniversary approaches, the College is developing an innovative and dynamic Facilities Master Plan. Higher demand for classes and degrees, new technologies and new ways to learn are challenging PCC to re-envision itself and its future.

In the first six months of 2014, three architectural firms, AC Martin, HGA and Gensler developed conceptual facility master plans to inform PCC's campus development over the next 25 + years. Their plans have been informed by several District-wide visioning workshops, internal discussions with faculty and staff, as well as evaluation of the campus and needs for its future growth.

The College is choosing a Facility Master Planner – not a design architect. The Selected Firm will help to determine how to maximize the use of the Campus land and its resources, determine how to best meet growth and desired capacity for the College. This includes locating buildings, determining transportation and parking needs, connections and flow of the campus, identifying gateways and central core points of the campus and where and how landscape should be enhanced.

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
